

Active Voice & Passive Voice
[Be + Past Participle]

Active

In an active clause or active sentence, the grammatical subject is the person or thing that performs the action given in the verb.

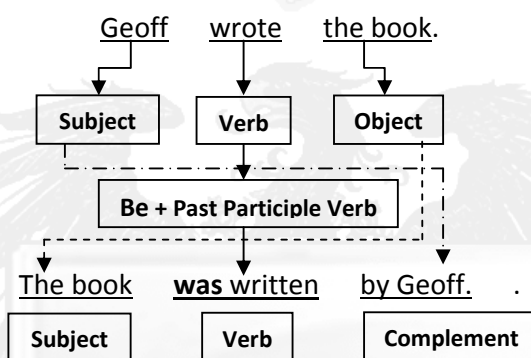
E.g.:- Geoff wrote the book.

Passive

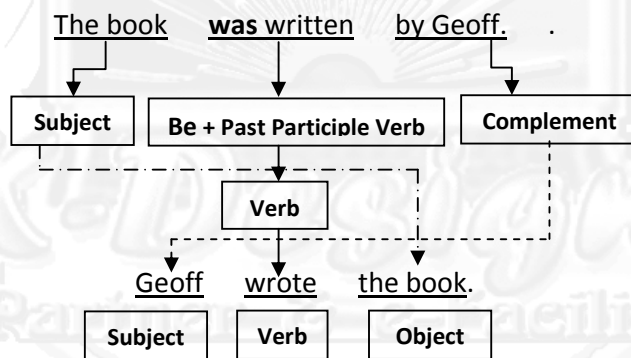
In a passive clause or passive sentence, the grammatical subject is the person or thing that experiences the effect of the action given in the verb.

E.g.:- The book was written by Geoff.

❖ **How to change an active sentence into a passive sentence..?**



❖ **How to change a passive sentence into an active sentence..?**



Note:

- In these sentences, the 'Be' verb indicates the tense.
- Verbs with no objects (Intransitive Verb) don't have a Passive Form, such as "The baby fell."
- There are some exceptions such as "He resembles a cat." This verb can't be changed to the Passive Form.

Write	Writing	Wrote	Written
Play	Playing	Played	Played
